

Ordinance to Appoint Alternate Members to the Board of Review

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 70.47(6m)(c) authorizes the appointment of alternate members to serve on the board of review when standing members are removed from individual cases;

Now, therefore, the (Town/Village/3rd or 4th class cities) Board of
Bennett, Douglas County does
ordain as follows:

1. ADOPTION

Pursuant to Wis. Stat. §§ 70.47(6m)(c) and 70.46(1), the (town/village) board hereby provides for the appointment of alternates to serve on the (town/village) Board of Review in the event a standing board member of the Board of Review is removed or unable to serve for any reason.

2. APPOINTMENTS

(The town/village/city may name as many alternates as they deem necessary to meet the statutory requirement that no fewer than three Board of Review members are needed to make a final determination of an objection to the property assessment.)
